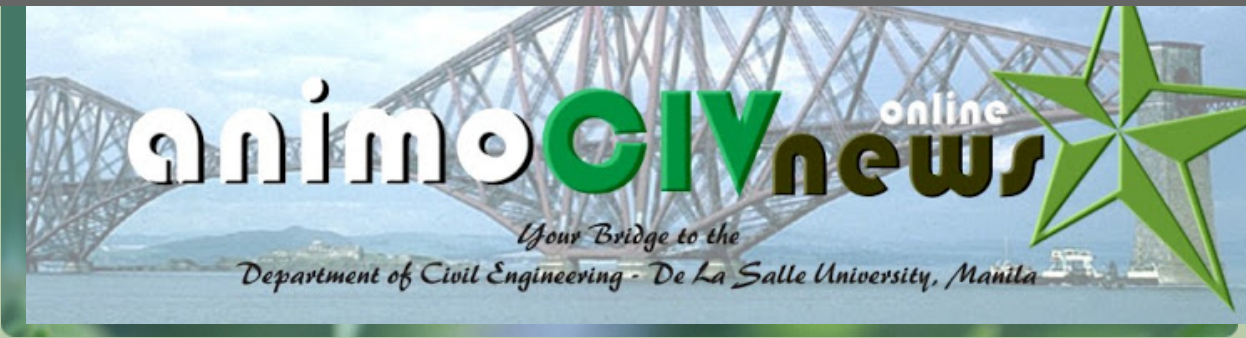

LOCALISING STRATEGIES FOR MAKING CITIES RESILIENT TO DISASTERS Workshp



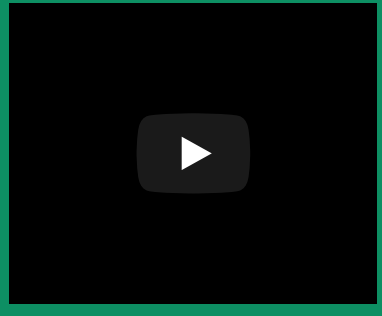

3. PANEL DISCUSSIONS (PD)

5. PARTICIPANTS' POSTER PRESENTATION (PPP)

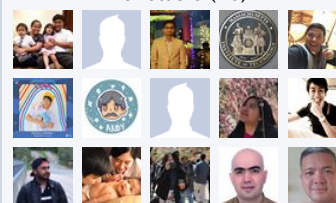
