## REbuilding After Displacement

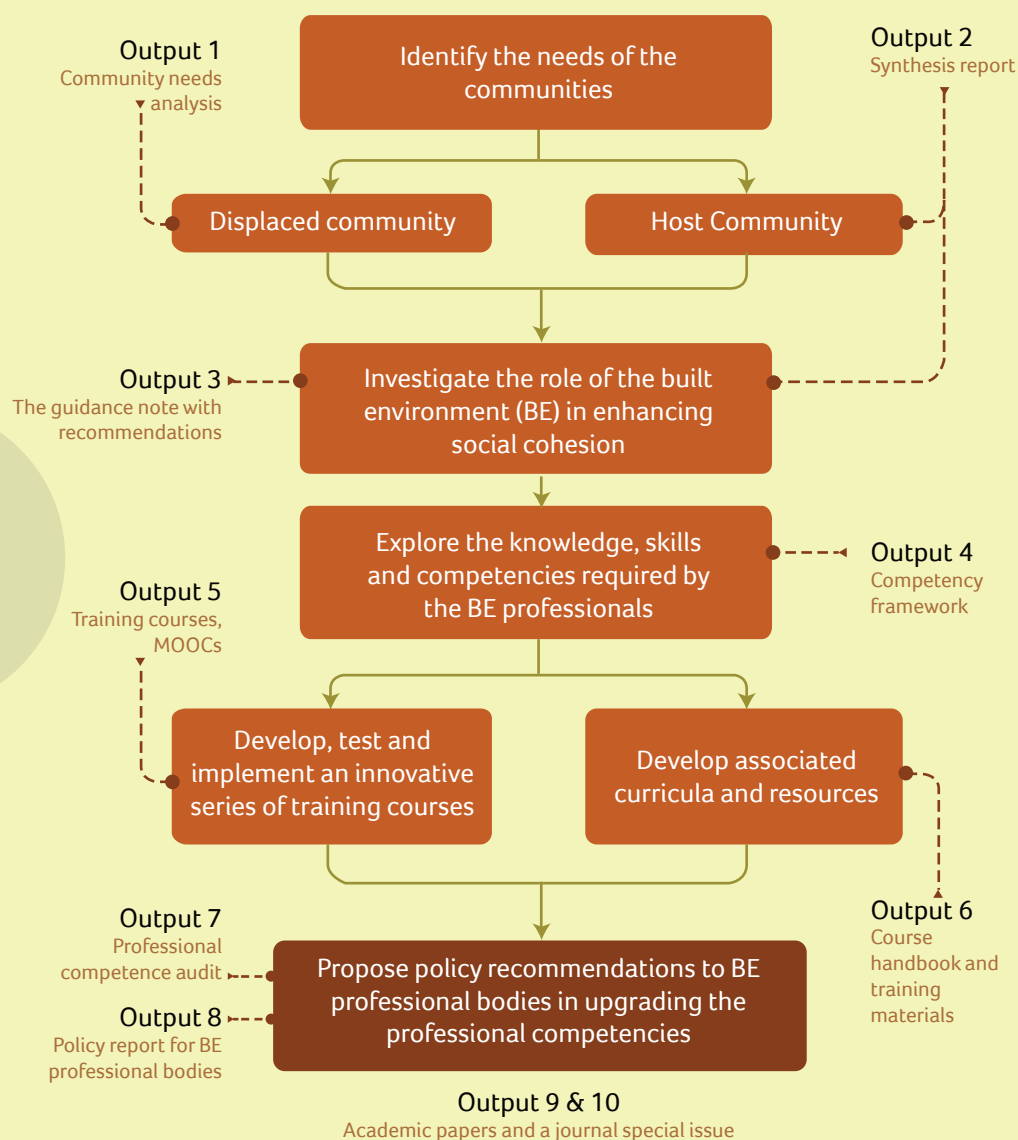

### ● Research problem

Immediately following a disaster or conflict, many communities will undergo resettlement as a process of recovery. Resettlement is also a process that introduces a new environment for the displaced. This new built environment potentially redefines the social system as one interlinked with other subsystems of the community.

The Built Environment perspective of post-disaster and conflict-induced displacement has less academic engagement and is seldom addressed in policies. A comprehensive approach is needed to fill in the built environment professional's competency gaps and policy gaps of disaster and conflict-induced displacements.
